SUMMER CAMP

Policies, Procedures and
General Information Booklet

Welcome to All American Gymnastics Summer Camp! The summer camp experiences for your child (children) will be terrific! We have held this program for many years, and we are excited to be offering it to you.

This packet has been compiled to acquaint you with the Summer Camp structure, explain the necessary rules, fees, and answer some of your questions. Please retain these pages for future reference.

CAMP GROUPINGS

Grouping Policy: The campers (boys and girls) will be grouped by age. The grouping of siblings, relatives and friends will follow the Grouping Policy and are at the discretion of the Camp Director. The age requirements for attending camp are as follows:

Minimum age of 5 years old (Must be going into kindergarten)

Maximum age of 13 years old

Monday – Friday 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM (Extended Care available from 3:00pm-5:00pm)

Drop Off Begins at 7:30 AM

There are NO refunds for camp fees.

ACTIVITIES

The campers' daily routine will be filled with structured activities such as: sports, games (indoor / outdoor), arts & crafts, gym play time, movies, themed weeks, field trips, special guest appearances and more.

RULES OF BEHAVIOR

The safety of all campers is our priority. This can only be maintained by campers knowing and following these rules daily.

Occasionally, situations will arise, and a child will have difficulty following the Camp rules of behavior. These incidents are documented and will be discussed with the individuals picking up the children. Our staff will work with both the parent and the camper to see if the problem can be resolved.

Please discuss the following rules thoroughly with your child before signing your agreement with AAGA for Summer Camp.

*Treat all campers and counselors with respect, including personal boundaries (i.e., no hugging, sitting on laps, etc...)

*Unfortunately, AAGA has experienced severe behavior or incidents from campers such as pushing, biting, spitting, hitting, bullying, using inappropriate language or destruction of property. **This type of behavior will NOT be tolerated and can be grounds for immediate TERMINATION of the camper without any parent conference and NO REFUND of any camp fees.**

Pick-up Policy

It is essential that parents pick up their children from camp on time. A staff member is required to stay at the gym until every camper is picked up. In some instances, staff members are paying for baby-sitting during their work hours. When a staff member must stay and “baby-sit” after the camp is over, it costs the staff money. A \$5.00 fee will be charged to your credit card for every ten minutes you are late. We will give a five minute “grace period”. Below is an example chart explaining the time increments:

Camp Starts / Building Opens at 7:30 am / After Care is over at 5:00 pm

Camper is picked up:			
Between 5:00-5:05	Between 5:06-5:15	Between 5:16-5:25	Between 5:26-5:30
No charge	\$5.00	\$10.00	\$15.00

For all children’s safety, it is critical to sign in your child when entering the building.

Addition to Policy: At the bottom of the contract please provide a list of additional people who have the authority to pick up your child(ren). If someone other than those listed on the contract will be picking up your child(ren), you must notify an AAGA staff member when you drop off your child, or by either phone or email. Your child will not be released without prior authorization.

ATTIRE

Campers are expected to come to camp in clothes suitable for activity. Boys should come wearing t-shirt and shorts / sweatpants. Girls should come wearing a leotard or full t-shirt (no crop tops: the belly button must be covered) and shorts / sweatpants. Girls should NOT come wearing a dress or skirt. Jeans or jean shorts should not be worn due to rivets/metal or possibly rhinestones causing damage and are not flexible enough for gym activities.

SUPPLIES

Every camper must bring a backpack (**ONE ONLY**) to hold ALL their belongings. If everything does not fit in the backpack, please purchase a BIGGER backpack. Items in the backpack include, but not limited to: Lunch, towel, swimsuit/swim trunks, hand sanitizer, sunscreen, water bottle etc...

Please label all your child's belongings to avoid lost items.

SNACK AND LUNCHTIME

Campers must supply their own lunch, snacks, and drinks.

Snacks and lunch are available for purchase in the Yakkity Yak Coffee Shack. In addition to accepting cash, Yakkity Yak sells Camp Bucks in the form of a gift card which you may load any amount you wish onto and are reloadable. We will keep your child's card and daily receipts on file and will send home with your child at the end of the week so you can review purchases and keep track of spending.

If a camper is not sent with a lunch/snack and drink, the following options are available:

- Parents must return and drop off lunch / snack and drink.
- A \$11.00 fee will be charged to your credit card in jackrabbit for your child to purchase a lunch from the Yakkity Yak Coffee Shop

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Electronics' usage

- AAGA is NOT responsible for any electronics brought by campers.
- Cell phones / tablets / gaming systems will be allowed ONLY at a scheduled time.

Out of Facility Policy

- Leaving AAGA without permission of the parent/guardian or camp counselor is NOT allowed.

Facility Policies

- For the safety of all the campers, stacking mats to create "forts / hiding areas is NOT allowed.
- Parents will need to train their children on proper bathroom usage. Parents should send an extra pair of clothing for children under the age of 7 in the case of "accidents".

Medication Policy

- If your child has any medication that he/she needs to take, on the contract, please give a brief description, the daily amount, and what medications he / she needs. These medications MUST be brought to the gym daily in a small zip lock bag clearly marked with the child's name, dosage, and what

times to be administered. Only medications brought by a parent and/or legal guardian will be given to the child, this includes over-the-counter medications.
